

Historic Hurricanes

- Choose random date between 1850 and now using <https://www.random.org/calendar-dates/>. You need a year and a month.
- Go to <https://coast.noaa.gov/hurricanes/>. Click on 'select all basins', then filter for your randomly chosen year and month
- Find a tropical cyclone *that makes landfall* (i.e. hits lands).
 - Describe its life – where did it start, how did it grow (over how many days, while travelling where etc.)
 - Describe what people would have seen and experienced at the landfall point.
- Do more
 - If you use Google Earth Pro (https://www.google.co.uk/intl/en_uk/earth/versions/) you can find the landfall point and explore historic aerial imagery to see how the area has changed. Is it more urbanised, is the coast eroding, can you see evidence of change? This could help you describe the experience of landfall.
