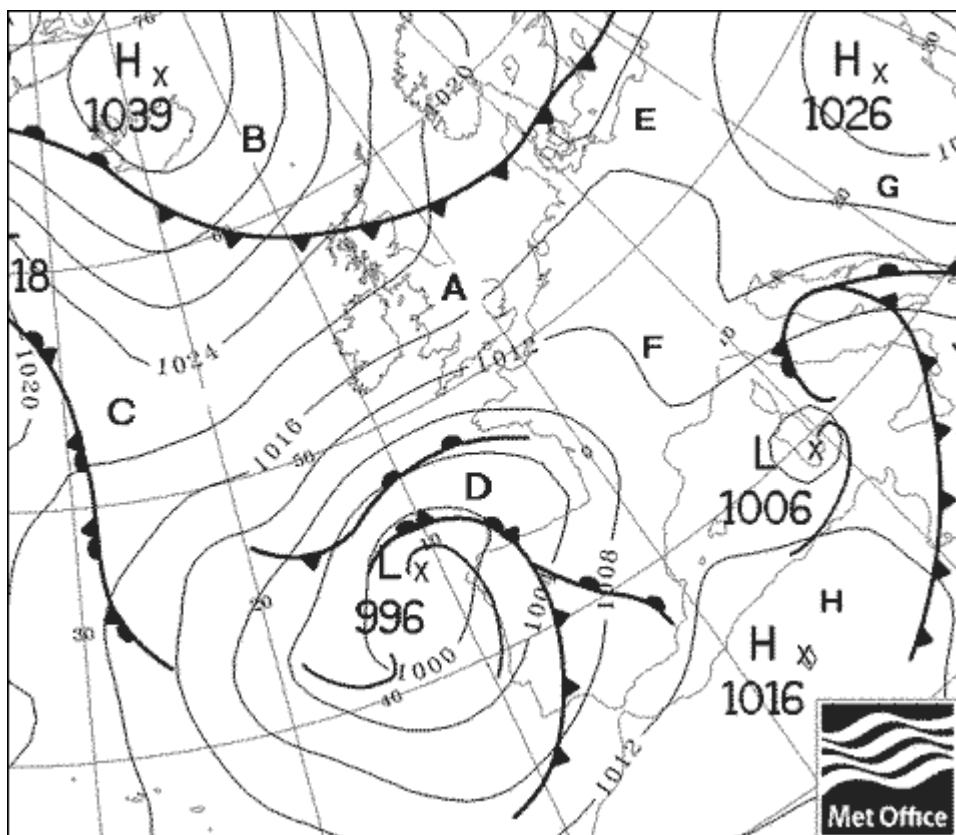


Understanding weather charts
