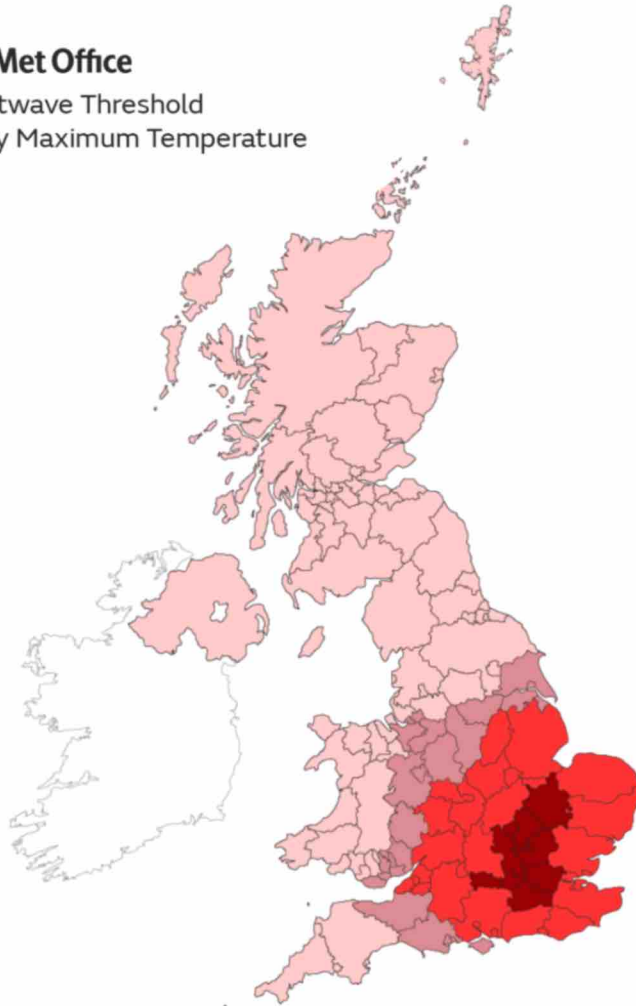


Find out how temperatures in my area could be affected by global warming
